

Opening of Feeder schools in Flood Relief Camp (Govt. Boys Comprehensive School, Multan) 31st Aug. 2010

NCHD team has decided to open feeder schools to get the children out of psychological depression, and to involve them in different activities.

Feeder schools were opened on 13th Aug. 2010. Nine volunteers were identified as teachers, who initiated joyful learning through telling stories and playing games with children. A donor provided toys and flash cards.



A series of meetings was arranged with EDO-E, resulting in the Education Department deciding to provide books to all affected children in the Relief Camps. These books were distributed by DEO (EE-W) Mrs. Nusrat Firdos. She appreciated the efforts of NCHD Team.
