

Free Medical Camp Palam, Ushrai Dara, Upper Dir

A free medical camp was organized by NCHD Upper Dir at UC Palam on 19/08/2010. Two Doctors were involved to treat the patients. More than 300 patients were treated and medicines were given free of cost on record. The medicines distributed have an estimated cost of 60,000 Rupees. Upper Dir, DCO's role was commendable in this connection who facilitated NCHD in organizing the free medical camp. PPHI and EDO Health Provided technical support and Dr. Latif participated voluntarily for patients' checkup. Volunteers mobilized community in helping and motivating the affected people to come to the medical camp. The people of the area appreciated the efforts of NCHD upper Dir for the treatment of the affected and deserving people, and pledged that they will cooperate with it in their future endeavors.

Note: - It is to be mentioned that this was the worst hit area where 27 people died and scores are missing due to thunder storms. Due to damage to communication links, NCHD had to transport medicines packets on shoulders.
